**The site is on a stubble field with some ruts & irregularities and will be open from 8.30 am**

**PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE BEFORE THIS TIME**

- **PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR TENT/GAZEBO WILL FIT INTO THE ALLOCATED FOOTAGE OF 12ft - THIS MUST INCLUDE YOUR GUY ROPES**
- ***IF YOU EXTEND BEYOND YOUR SPACE YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO MOVE EVEN IF YOU HAVE SET UP. IF IN DOUBT REQUEST A LARGER SITE***

## OTHER POINTS

- The committee reserve the right to reject applications
- Spaces on site will be allocated in order of arrival on the day of the Fair
- No overnight camping without express permission from the committee. If you require a camping pitch please contact us to see if this would be possible (it may not be available, you do so at entirely your own risk and no services are provided)
- All cars must be removed to behind their stall or to where allocated before 10.30 am
- You will need table and chairs, waste bin and washing facilities if selling food
- Please clear your pitch at the end of the day, putting any rubbish in the bins around the site and placing in the skip on site
- There will be a number of food stalls run by local organisations and it is hoped that these will be patronised. Should you bring your own food please remember that the fair is on agricultural land and there is a **SITE BAN** on disposable bottles, ring-pull cans, plastic boxes etc.
- No canned or bottled drinks to be sold by stall-holders
- Note that the Fair's tea tent does not start serving until 11.00 a.m.
